If you read one book\* per decade (1970's, 1980's, 1990's, 2000's, 2010's) you will receive five (5) raffle tickets for a chance to win one of several fabulous prizes; if you complete 2 rounds of the challenge, then you will receive an additional five (5) raffle tickets and so on. The more rounds you document and complete on the attached form, the more chances you have to win. The prize winners will be announced at our Gala Benefit to be held at the United Theatre on September 30, 2022. (No purchase necessary to enter contest and you do not have to be present at the Gala to win.)

The challenge is open to all age groups and the reason we request our readers ages as prizes will be broken down by age category: seniors, adult, teens, tweens, and kids.

\*In addition to books, audiobooks qualify; all fiction and nonfiction genres including graphic novels, poetry, essays, romance, mysteries, biographies, etc. are eligible for the contest.
